Dear Parents, Guardians, and Students of the Class of 2022:

Prospect High School's 62nd Commencement will be held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, May 18th. This letter and the accompanying materials contain important information concerning commencement for the Class of 2022.

Commencement is a very special occasion in the lives of students and their families, and it is conducted with a balance of solemnity and celebration. During the ceremony, approximately five hundred graduates will receive their diploma covers as they walk across the stage to receive congratulations from school officials. Attached is a more detailed schedule, along with guidelines for the event.

The plan is to conduct commencement outside in the George Gattas Memorial Stadium at Prospect High School.

As in recent years, we have ordered soft graduation caps in lieu of the traditional hard mortarboards. This allows students to partake in a unified cap-throwing celebration at the conclusion of the ceremony.

Please note:

- Attendance at graduation rehearsal is <u>required</u> for students to participate in commencement.
- A student who chooses not to participate in commencement must notify me in writing by Monday, May 2nd. A parent/guardian signature is required if the student is under the age of eighteen.

Graduation Rehearsal

- Graduation rehearsal is mandatory for all who choose to participate in the ceremony. Rehearsal is Wednesday, May 18, 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Please meet at the Stadium.
- Students who have met all school obligations (library fines, return of books, financial obligations, etc.) will be given their two commemorative tickets at the rehearsal.
- After rehearsal, seniors are free to leave campus and do not need to return until 5:30 p.m.

Graduate Arrival and Ceremony Time

- Graduates should report to the Walker Field House appropriately attired with cap and gown at 5:30 p.m. Graduates will enter through doors 23 and 24.
- Stadium gate opens at 6:00 p.m for guests.
- Graduates should leave all valuables at home.
- The ceremony will begin at 7:00 p.m. and last approximately 1½ hours.





Tickets

 Tickets are NOT needed for the outdoor ceremony. There will be a variety of seating options and wheelchair accessibility for our guests. Students receive 2 commemorative tickets during the graduation practice. These are only for keepsakes and are not needed for admission.



Dress Code

- For the safety of the students participating in the commencement ceremony as they walk on the turf, up and down steps, and across the stage, graduates are expected to follow the guidelines below for acceptable dress. Students not adhering to this dress code will not be permitted to participate in the ceremony.
- Girls: Dress, skirt and top, or dress slacks and top are all appropriate. Because of the artificial turf, absolutely no spiked heels are allowed. We strongly recommend flats or shoes with stacked heels (no tennis shoes, sports shoes or "flip-flops"). Jeans or shorts are unacceptable.
- Boys: Collared shirt (optional tie), dress slacks, and dress shoes (no tennis shoes, sports shoes, sandals, or "flip-flops"). Jeans or shorts are unacceptable.

Photography

- Professional Photography: Lifetouch Photography will photograph graduates immediately after they receive their diploma covers.
- Proofs will be mailed home 2-3 weeks after the graduation ceremony. Portraits can be viewed online at Events.lifetouch.com. For questions regarding photography, please contact Lifetouch Photography at 800-505-9496.
- Guests may not leave their seats to take photographs.
