# Post Secondary Planning – Senior Year

# Applying to College - Senior Year

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Complete letter of recommendation form

Take SAT (required)/ ACT (some colleges are test optional)

How to apply:

Application on college website

Common Application

Request letter of recommendation (if applicable) from teacher or counselor

(provide 2 week notice for all letters of recommendation)

# Applying to College – Senior Year

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Request transcript

Refer to CCC calendar for upcoming events

Complete FAFSA - required of all graduating seniors

Attend virtual open houses and college fairs

Meet virtually with college representatives

Watch for scholarship information
