PROOF OF RESIDENCE REQUIREMENTS

- PRODUCE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
 - Current Signed apartment lease
 - Copy of closing document (if new home purchase)
 - Copy of Mortgage Statement
 - Most recent Real Estate tax bill

PLUS:

PRODUCE TWO OF THE FOLLOWING (Must show new address and be current):

- Utility bill (electric, gas, water, cable)
- ~ Employee identification
- Car/homeowner's/renter's insurance statement
- Voter or Vehicle Registration Card
- City Vehicle Sticker
- ~ Public Aid, Snap, All Kids
- Driver License

• <u>Parents/Guardians must obtain the following form previous school PRIOR TO REGISTRATION APPOINTMENT:</u>

- State of Illinois Transfer Form (Illinois Public Schools only)
- Unofficial transcript and current grades from previous high school attended
- ~ Course selection from previous high school attended (if available)
- ~ Copy of Physical/Immunization Record
- Copy of Current IEP or 504 Plan, if applicable
- ELL Students most recent ACCESS scores
- Original Birth Certificate (Hospital issued birth certificates not acceptable)
- Out-of-State/Private School Student Transfer form verifying student is not suspended or expelled.
- <u>Transfer/incoming Freshman Students must provide a Physical/Immunization Record in order to begin school. Physical must be current within one year and done within the State of Illinois.</u>

If student and parent are living with another family in EGHS attendance area, we will need:

- A statement from owner/lessee (person with whom you are living) indicating that the student and parent are living at their address on a permanent basis, along with proof of residency as indicated above.
- ~ Proof of Residency in the parent's name as indicated above (within 45 days).
