Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s) of a Student Attending Prom, and Student:

As the weather warms, thoughts are drawn to the end of the year activities including Prom. We hope this event is a memorable and happy occasion for your family! We would like to remind each of our Prom attendees of the guidelines which are designed to ensure a pleasant and safe experience for all.

Prom is scheduled for May 03, 2025, at the **Lincolnshire Marriott** and runs from **7:00 pm until 11:30 PM**. As always, attendance will be taken, and the doors will open at 6:30 PM. **If a student does not arrive at the venue by 7:45 PM, they will not be admitted in, and no refunds will be issued. Please ensure that your student has a ride promptly after the Prom ends at 11:30 PM.**

All students and their possessions are subject to search upon entry. In the event that a student shows signs of ANY use of alcohol or drugs, the student's parents will be called to pick up their child. A school drug and alcohol conference will be scheduled, severe disciplinary consequences will be determined, and a police referral will be made. Also, Prom is tobacco free, regardless of age. Violation by a senior could endanger graduation. Finally, we expect that all attendees will behave appropriately, or they will be asked to leave, and their parents will be called. Students with outstanding detentions will be denied entrance, regardless if tickets were purchased, and no refunds will be issued.

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

To ensure a perfect evening for all, the following guidelines will be set.

- For Non-WHS students attending as guests, students must complete and submit Guest Forms to the Attendance Office by 3 pm on Monday, April 7th.
- Students are prohibited from purchasing tickets for unapproved guests. Approval may take 24-48 hours. Refer to page 10 for the Guest Form.

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

District 214 School Dance Policy allows a student to bring **one** guest to a school-sponsored dance providing that the following information is completed prior to the event. **This form must be completed and approved before purchasing tickets for the dance. Students will only be allowed to purchase tickets on Saturday, April 12th from 8am to 1pm.** Any student who brings a guest to the dance is responsible for ensuring their guest follows all District 214 rules regarding conduct at the dance. All students and their possessions are subject to search upon entry.

Guests must be at least in 9th grade, maximum age is 20 years old. A photocopy of the guest's school ID or current driver's license must be attached to this form. Faxed copies will not be accepted. A guest must have the appropriate picture ID for admittance on the night of the dance.

Students arriving one and a half hours late or more (from the time the door opens) may not attend the dance and there will be no refunds. **No one will be admitted after 7:45 pm.**
